The week at Tar Heel Girls State will provide you with many opportunities for learning, developing leadership skills, meeting new people, and having fun.


- Participants, we call them citizens, will be grouped in cities to organize their own local government, electing officers, preparing a city charter and conducting city activities.

- Between the ages of 16 and 18 years old.
- Ranked in the top 1/3 of her class or have an unweighted GPA of 3.0.
- Resident of NC for 1 year prior to selection and be currently attending a NC high school.
- Must be a U.S. Citizen or legal resident of the U.S.

Eligibility requirements: Be a college bound rising senior with at least one semester remaining next year. Must maintain a 3.0 unweighted GPA, possess strong leadership qualities, and be motivated to preserve our great republic.

Candidate will attend Tar Heel Boys State June 18-24, 2023 at Catawba College, Salisbury, NC. No other activities can interfere during this week.

The one-page screening document is due back to your counselor by March 15, 2023. Ensure your counselor completes his/her portion of the document before notifying me that it is ready for pick up.

Finalists will be scheduled for brief interviews in March or early April. Interviews will take place at the American Legion building on 403 St. Andrews Dr, Greenville, NC, after school hours.

Candidates selected to go forward after the interviews will be given the Boys State application and paperwork to complete along with the due date.

We may invite some delegates to attend an American Legion Post 39 monthly meeting to give a brief overview of their Boys State experience and thank the members for sponsoring them. Dinner is free for the delegate and two guests.
